19.30: Human chain around the former synagogue / Ettinghausenplatz


On 27.01.2022 – the anniversary of the liberation of the Auschwitz concentration camp – and especially in these pandemic times, we stand up for a just society based on solidarity and refuse to be used or drowned out by conspiracy theorists, anti-Semites, racists, right-wing radicals and neo-Nazis.

**Once and for all:
Fascism is not an opinion, it is a crime!**

A clear 2/3 majority of the population has actively opted for solidarity as a solution. We are the majority of this society: vaccinated and supporting the workers in the health care professions and hospitals, the emergency services and the public infrastructure, the teachers and educators, and we are the rebuy protecting everyone from the intensive care unit – ourselves and our relatives and children.

Especially on 27.01.22, we will not allow the “anti-vaccination protests” of so-called lateral “thinkers” – centrally controlled via “Telegram” and social media – to roll through Höchst, Frankfurt and the Rhine-Main region every week, and certainly not through places of remembrance like the former Jewish synagogue in Höchst.

We believe that no matter what anyone's opinion of a vaccination mandate is, we all must work together to actively defend the basic democratic values of our society – surely a lesson from the Nazi era. Part of this is a clear dissociation and exclusion of right-wing radicals and neo-fascists.



Only reason, solidarity and cohesion can help against Corona! Those who walk with Nazis have learned nothing!

This is what we, residents' initiatives, associations, citizens from Höchst and the western districts, together with the trade unions IG Metall, IG BCE, the Association of the Persecuted of the Nazi Regime and all democratic parties, want to express, and we call on everyone to actively join and participate.

We won't be silent: we act! Now!

Timeline:

from 17.30: Gathering at Höchster Schlossplatz

18.00: Rally at Höchster Schlossplatz

followed by: Demonstration through Höchst leading to Ettinghausenplatz (former Jewish synagogue at the Höchst market)

19.30: Human chain around the former synagogue (Ettinghausenplatz) and joint final rally on the market square

“On 27 January 1945, soldiers of the Red Army liberated the concentration camps of Auschwitz, where more than a million people had been murdered by the Nazis. Liberation day has now become the International Holocaust Remembrance Day.”



Closing ranks also works at a distance!

We protect ourselves and everyone at the demonstration and rally. Our hygiene rules:

All participants are asked to sanitise their hands and take a rapid test before the rally and to abide by the “AHA rules” (*social distancing, hygiene and masking*) at the rally.

All participants must keep a distance of 1.5 m, which is monitored by the stewards of the organisers.

All participants are required to wear masks throughout the demonstration and rallies. Participants who do not comply with these instructions will be excluded from the demonstration.

Participants who do not want to wear masks, do not comply with the distance rules, spread conspiracy theories, right-wing, radical right-wing and neo-fascist ideas at the demonstration are expressly not wanted there and will be excluded as troublemakers by the organisers.
